Social, green, and fair.

These coming elections you decide the future of our country. In our province, the water councils, and the Senate.

A strong Labour Party is more important than ever. To stop the advancing commercialisation. So you can pay your energy bill on a normal wage. So we can build affordable housing for young and old. For a fair and green climate policy. To protect our natural world. Against polluting our landscape with distribution centres, where migrant workers are being exploited as well. For green energy of which local residents can benefit. For safe swimming waters and a healthy environment. We fight for a social, green, and fair world. Vote Labour on March 15th.

Here we will tell you about our plans, so you know exactly what you're voting for.

Housing

A good and affordable roof over your head is no longer guaranteed. If it's up to us, you'll once again be able to rent or buy a house. We will give housing corporations the space they need. We're focusing on building sustainably, energy-neutral and nature friendly. And we're tackling the excesses on the housing market. Our plans in short:

- Affordable housing is hard to find. That is why we're building more:
 - Social housing until the waiting time is one year at most in every region;
 - Houses to be bought for a max of €250.000 and to be rented for a max of €1.000 a month.
- We're going for sustainable housing. So:
 - Enough surrounding green and accessible by public transportation and bike;
 - New housing must be well-isolated. We take our climate and nature into account by using organic building materials.
- Migrant workers, refugees and the homeless need a roof over their heads too. Every municipality has to provide its fair share of accommodations for these groups. No more letting neighbouring municipalities do all the hard work.

Jobs and the economy

The Labour Party puts people and planet above commercial profits. The emphasis has to be on jobs for which people want to live and on which they can get by. Not on jobs which just allow you to survive. The amount of landscape we have is limited, and should be protected. We are choosing for a social, green and fair economy. Our plans in short:

- People have to be able to switch to the jobs of the future while maintaining their salary. That is why we are investing in re-education.
- Vocational training and more people in engineering, health care, education, police forces and defence forces are most important.

- No more distribution centres and data centres. This way our landscape stays beautiful, and we limit the abuse of migrant workers.
- Vocational colleges (MBO schools) and the private sector will have more apprenticeships for all students if it's up to us.
- You should always have decent access to general practitioners, supermarkets, ATMs, primary schools and regional hospitals.

Energy

We need green investments. Not just because our planet needs to be kept livable and healthy, but also because you should be able to pay your energy bill. We will fight energy poverty and will generate more green energy. Our plans in short:

- We will build as many wind turbines and solar panels as possible.
- At least 50% of the green energy should be locally owned.
- We will make sure that you can live in a well-isolated home, with lower energy costs by means of subsidies and standardisations.

Climate and the environment

We need to make room for our nature if we want to combat climate change. The profits of big polluters have led to general impoverishment. Our plans in short:

- We're planting more trees in South Holland. Those increase the planets' habitability, lower the temperatures in the summer, and absorb CO₂.
- We will create enough space for water collection, so that floods caused by climate change can be prevented.
- We will monitor polluting companies more closely, and will issue higher fines. Revoking permits is a serious option for us if companies do not reduce their pollution.

Public transportation and cycling

Bicycles and public transportation are the most important means of transportation for the Labour Party. For many people, they are the only way to go to family, the doctor, work or school. We are focusing on affordable and better public transportation connections, bicycle lanes, and walking routes. Our plans in short:

- We are investing in better public transportation, so that every city and village centre is accessible during the day, night and weekends.
- We are investing in safer bicycle lanes, bicycle highways and bicycle parking spaces near train stations, important bus, tram and metro stops and in inner cities. Busy bicycle lanes will be widened, or we'll build a new lane nearby. That is how the bicycle remains a healthy, attractive and green choice.
- Quality health care should be and remain accessible. So, ambulances should be able to arrive on time, and hospitals should be easy to reach everywhere.
- Traffic safety is very important. The locations with the highest probability of accidents will be dealt with first.
